Significant Rules Changes 2019-2020

- **4-2-1, 4-2-1a (NEW) 4-2-1e (NEW), 4-2-2 (NEW)**
 - Eliminates the solid-colored uniform requirements, establishes that the libero uniform must clearly contrast with his/her teammates' uniforms and reorganizes the legal uniform rule.
 - *Rationale:* Clarifies the requirements for all legal uniforms and simplifies the requirements for the contrasting libero uniform maintaining the compliance of all currently compliant team and libero uniform jerseys.



Significant Rules Changes 2019-2020

- **4-2-4b**

- Eliminates the use of double zero (00) as a uniform number option.
- *Rationale:* Eliminates confusion surrounding the signaling of “00” and “0”.



Significant Rules Changes 2019-2020

- **4-2-4c**

- Beginning with the **2023** season the body of the **uniform number must clearly contrast with the uniform top regardless of borders**. This will eliminate the allowance of borders to provide contrast between the number and the uniform number.
- *Rationale:* Allows officials and scorers to easily identify uniform numbers.



Significant Rules Changes 2019-2020

• 5-9-2 NOTE

- Establishes that the line judge shall take their position and move in line with the extension of the end line when the ball is being served near the line judge's position replacing the old technique to move directly back in line with the sideline.
- *Rationale:* Allows the line judge to watch for foot contact with the end line and move quickly back for a view of the sideline. This is a more appropriate position and transition for line judges.



Significant Rules Changes 2019-2020

- **8-2-5g (NEW), 8-2-6d**

- Establishes that the ball remains dead when tossed for serve and it touches any part of the backboard or supports hanging in a vertical position over the serving area and is an illegal serve (Signal 14: out of bounds) and not a service fault.
- *Rationale:* Accurately reflects the action since the ball is not contacted for serve.



Significant Rules Changes 2019-2020

- 4-2-7

- Clarifies the penalty for the removal of any part of the uniform top or bottom as a yellow card charged to the coach for unsporting conduct.
 - *Consequence:* The coach must remain seated for the remainder of the match.



Significant Rules Changes 2019-2020

- **5-5-3b (26)**

- Provides additional instructions for the second referee when conducting the coin toss prior to the deciding set by requiring the second referee to communicate with the first referee the serving team and the proper team benches.
- The first referee signals (no whistle) to direct teams to their bench.



Significant Rules Changes 2019-2020

- **8-1-6, 8-2-5g**
 - Establishes the proper signal for a tossed ball that contacts a backboard or its supports hanging in a vertical position over the serving area is officials' signal 14 (out of bounds).



Significant Rules Changes 2019-2020

- **NFHS Official Signals Chart**

- Removes signal 7 “Legal Back-Row Attack” from the chart and establishes the signal as an informal officials’ signal in the NFHS Officials Manual renumbering remaining signals.
